#### **Ministry Goals and Strategies**

3. Revitalisation of parishes in the region and assistance for provisional parishes to attain full parish status.

Action: Hornsby Heights, Harbord and Lavender Bay have now become full parishes.

4. Evangelism: To foster a culture of outreach and evangelism in the churches of the region.

Action: Evangelism has continued with part-time regional evangelists, John Dickson, Barry Newman and Stuart Robinson from Evangelism Ministries (training).

5. Children & Families: Goal: to appoint a specialist Children's Worker in the region by 2001.

Action: John Clewer appointed 1 February 2001 for 3 days a week - subsequently raised to 4 days a week. The Clewers live at Dundas Valley just outside the region.

6. *CCM Church Plant:* Goal: to plant a church in the Hornsby area for Chinese people who speak Mandarin.

Action: \$20,000 allocated in 2002 for this ministry based at All Saints' Waitara. Awaiting implementation. The Rev Peter Chung is working one day a week contacting Mandarin speakers from a base at St Peter's Hornsby (2002).

7. Northern TAFE ministries: Goal: to establish bases in 5 major campuses of the Northern Region over the next 5 years.

Action: Phill Hirons leading a small team at Ryde/Meadowbank and Hornsby TAFE.
