An Ordinance for accepting and adopting sections 1 to 6 of and the Schedule to The Act of Uniformity Amendment Act 1872 (England) as an Ordinance of this Synod.

WHEREAS it is expedient that the use of the shortened forms of Morning and Evening Prayer mentioned in the above Act should be permitted in the Diocese of Sydney as they are in England the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales ordains and rules as follows:—

- 1. That sections 1 to 6 of the above mentioned Act be adopted as clauses of this Ordinance as if they were repeated therein.
- 2. That the Schedule to the above mentioned Act be adopted as a Schedule to this Ordinance as if it were repeated herein.
