
Albury Ordinance 1979

No. 37, 1979

AN ORDINANCE to consent to the Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn surrendering certain territory to the Diocese of Wangaratta.

WHEREAS the Synod of the Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn is willing to surrender territory described in the Schedule hereto to the Diocese of Wangaratta and WHEREAS under clause 45 of The Constitution of the Church of England in Australia contained in the Schedule to the Church of England in Australia Constitutions Act 1961 the consent by ordinance of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney is required to that surrender as the Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn was formed from the Diocese of Sydney NOW the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney HEREBY ORDAINS RULES DECLARES AND DIRECTS as follows:—

1. This ordinance may be cited as the "Albury Ordinance 1979".
2. The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney hereby consents to the Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn surrendering the territory described in the Schedule hereto to the Diocese of Wangaratta.

All that part of the Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn which is situated within the Local Government areas of the City of Albury and the Shire of Hume.
