All Saints' Woollahra (Double Bay Building Fund) Ordinance 1951.

No. 18, 1951.

AN ORDINANCE to vary the trusts of the Double Bay Building Fund of the Parish of All Saints, Woollahra.

WHEREAS:-

- (a) A Fund known as the Double Bay Building Fund (hereinafter called "the Fund") was raised some years ago for the purpose of erecting Church buildings on land at Bellevue Road, Double Bay, comprised in Certificate of Title Volume 2515 Folio 246 (hereinafter called "the said land").
- (b) The said land has been sold in pursuance of the All Saints' Woollahra Land Sale Ordinance 1947.
- (c) No other land has been acquired or is proposed to be acquired in lieu of the said land.

Now therefore the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod ordains and declares as follows:—

- 1. By reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the trusts to which the Fund is subject it is expedient that such trusts be varied to the extent to which they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.
 - 2. The Fund may be used for the purposes of a Church Parsonage or Parish Hall or partly for one and partly for another or others of such purposes in connection with the Church of England in the Parish of All Saints' Woollahra.
 - 3. This Ordinance may be cited as "All Saints' Woollahra (Double Bay Buildling Fund) Ordinance 1951."
