Archbishop ex-officio member of certain bodies.

An Ordinance to provide that the Archbishop of Sydney shall be an ex officio member of certain bodies.

Whereas it is expedient to provide that the Archbishop of Sydney shall be an exufficiu member of all bodies elected by the Synod subject to certain necessary exemptions hereinafter specified The Synod of the Dioless of Sydney in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales ordains and rules as follows:—

- 1. The Archbishop of Sydney or in his absence the Administrator of the Diocese shall ex officia be an additional member of all bodies elected by the Synod other than bodies appointed under "The Tribunal Ordinance 1904" the Board of Nominators under the "Presentation Ordinance of 1895" the "Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Sydney" and the Council of The King's School and of all Committees and Sub-Committees appointed from time to time by such bodies.
- 2.—This Ordinance may be styled and cited as the "Archbishop Enabling Ordinance 1910."
