An opening service of Holy Communion will be held in the Cathedral at 1.00 pm, with Canon Simon Manchester preaching.

I am also pleased to summon the members of the 52nd Synod to a special session of the Synod of our Diocese to elect the next Archbishop of the See of Sydney, to be held in the Darling Harbour Theatre, International Convention Centre, commencing at 4:30pm on Tuesday, 4 May and daily thereafter at 6:30 pm from Wednesday, 5 May to Friday, 7 May 2021, unless we can finish earlier.

Canon Manchester has been invited to lead prayers and to deliver a Bible study at the beginning of each day of the special session.

Nominations

Any one or more members of the Synod may nominate any duly qualified person for the office of Archbishop of Sydney although a duly qualified person will be taken not to have been nominated to the office of Archbishop of Sydney unless one or more nominations signed by a total of not less than 20 members of Synod are received.

Nominations of duly qualified persons for the office of Archbishop of Sydney close at 5:00 pm on **Tuesday 23 March 2021**, and must –

- be signed by the nominator(s)
- specify an email address for service of notices on the nominator(s) and a postal and email address for service of notices on the nominee
- be given to the Nomination Officer, Mr Daniel Glynn
