Proposal to Change the Provisional Parish of Berowra to a Parish

(A Report from the North Sydney Regional Council.)

Initiation of Proposal

1. A proposal was made to the Archbishop by the Minister and Churchwardens of St Mark's Berowra under Clause 4 (1)(b) of the Parishes Ordinance 1979.

Details of Meeting

- 2. A meeting of the North Sydney Regional Council was held on 15 September 1998 to consider the proposal under Clause 5 of the Ordinance.
- 3. North Sydney Regional Council certified that all procedural requirements under Clauses 4 and 6 have been complied with and noted that no objections had been received.

Proposal

- 4. The proposal is to change the Provisional Parish to a Parish.
- 5. The Parish has been considering this change of status for some time but was not able to offer a rectory up to Diocesan standards. A very suitable rectory has now been provided.

Parish Information

- 6. There has been steady growth in the Parish and there is a clearly defined strategic plan covering ministry, finance and property in place.
- 7. In a total population of 11,248 some 3,511 claim affiliation with the Anglican Church. The church services a community of young families with higher than average income and a homogeneous population of those born in Australia or in other English speaking countries.
- 8. The Parish employs part-time pastoral workers and a part-time office secretary. There are both CEBS and GFS groups and 60 children in the Sunday School. Three playgroups are attended by 128 parents and children and supervised by a part-time co-ordinator.
- 9. St Mark's has approximately 150 core adult members. A further 80 adults attend regularly or occasionally. 138 children and youth are ministered to by the Parish.
