AN ORDINANCE to provide for the application of certain income derived during the occupancy of the See from the Church trust properties referred to in the "Sydney Diocesan Revenues Act of 1905."

WHEREAS the Chapel within the Episcopal Residence at Edgecliff is not large enough for present and prospective needs and it is expedient to build a new Chapel adjoining the said residence on the North and West and within the grounds of Bishopscourt at Edgecliff and to furnish the same WHEREAS plans and specifications have been prepared and tenders have been invited for the purposes of the undertaking AND WHEREAS an appeal is being or is about to be made for voluntary contributions to provide the funds necessary for carrying out the said undertaking WHEREAS certain income of the church trust properties referred to in the "Sydney Diocesan Revenues Act of 1905" derived during the occupancy of the See has accumulated and is not required for the purposes specified in the 6th Section of the said Act and the said mortgage therein mentioned has been discharged AND WHEREAS it is expedient to make provision for the application of the said income or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purposes hereafter mentioned The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the provisions of the said Act and of the "Church of England Constitutions Act Amendment Act of 1902" and of all other powers vested in the said Synod ordains and rules as follows:--

- 1. If and so far as funds provided or to be provided by voluntary contributions shall not be available for the payment as required from time to time of the expenses incurred and to be incurred in carrying out and completing the said undertaking of building and furnishing a new Chapel as aforesaid the said accumulated income or so much thereof as may be required may be temporarily used in payment of the said expenses as advances made on account of the said funds.
- 2. If and so far as funds provided or to be provided by voluntary contributions shall not within twelve months after the assent to this Ordinance become available for the payment of the whole of the expenses of carrying out and completing the said undertaking (including therein the said advances) the said

accumulated income or so much thereof as may be required for the said purpose (not exceeding the sum of Two thousand five hundred pounds [£2,500] without approval by resolution of the Standing Committee of the Synod) shall be applied absolutely towards the said undertaking.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as "Bishopscourt New Chapel Ordinance 1934."
