Bowral Sale Amending 1923.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the "St. Simon and St. Jude Bowral Sale Ordinance of 1920."

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the "St. Simon and St. Jude Bowral Sale Ordinance of 1920" in manner hereinafter provided AND WHEREAS by an Act of Parliament passed in the eighth year of the reign of His Majesty King George the Fifth entitled the "Church of England Trust Property Act 1917" (No. 21) it was enacted that during the recess of the Synod a Committee Council or other body of persons appointed for that purpose by Ordinance of Synod might in place of such Synod exercise such of the powers and functions referred to in the said Act as should be determined by Ordinance of the Synod AND WHEREAS by Ordinances of the Synod passed in the year One thousand nine hundred and eighteen and One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one respectively the Standing Committee was appointed for the purpose of exercising and accordingly might during the recess of the Synod of the Diocese exercise in the place of such Synod all or any of the powers and functions and do and make all or any of the things referred to in Sections 26 to 31 (inclusive) constituting Part VI, and Section 32 constituting Part VII. of the said Act. Now the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the said Act and Ordinances and in pursuance of the powers vested in the said Synod by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales and by the "Church of England Trust Property Act 1917" or otherwise in the name and in place of such Synod ordains directs and rules as follows:-

1. The "St. Simon and St. Jude Bowral Sale Ordinance of 1920" is hereby amended as follows:---

2 The following proviso shall be inserted at the end of clause two: Provided however that pending the sale of the whole of the said land the said Archbishop may from time to time at his discretion lease any part or parts thereof upon such terms and conditions as a may think fit with full power to grant any lessee an option of purchase in respect thereof under such stipulations as he may deem expedient.

- 3. By adding the following words after the word "sales" in line 1 clause 4: "and the net proceeds of leasing."
- 4. By adding the following words after the word "Church" in line 5 of sub-section (c) clause 4: "such payment to be calculated as commencing within eight months from the passing of this Ordinance."
- 5. A receipt or receipts from time to time heretofo a given by the Churchwardens for the time being of the said Parish shall be conclusive as to the proper allocation of all the moneys received and expended under the original Ordinance and the production of such receipt or receipts shall be a full and sufficient indemnity to the said Archbishop in respect thereof.
- 6. The following proviso shall be inserted at the end of subsection (c) clause 4: "Provided however that pending the receipt of the whole of the proceeds of sale of the said land the said Archbishop may from time to time at his discretion pay on account such sums as he may think fit in respect of the matters mentioned in sub-sections (a) (b) and (c) or any one of them.
- 7. By adding the following words after the word "sale" in line 1 clause 5: "and leasing."
- 8. This Ordinance may be styled and cited as "The St. Simon and St. Jude Bowral Sale Amending Ordinance of 1923."
