## Casual Vacancies Ordinance 1935.

### No. 11, 1935.

An Ordinance to deal with casual vacancies and for purposes incidental thereto.

WHEREAS the causes of casual vacancies and the tenure of office of persons appointed to fill such vacancies vary in the cases of the constitutions of the bodies hereinafter mentioned and it is expedient to provide uniformity in respect thereof and to amend The Elections Ordinance 1934. The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales ordains and rules as follows:—

- 1. Casual vacancies in offices filled or to be filled by Synod under any of the Ordinances Rules Regulations or Standing Orders mentioned in the schedule hereto shall arise upon:—
  - (a) Resignation in writing addressed to the Diocesan Secretary.
  - (b) Death.
  - (c) Bankruptcy or Assignment for the benefit of creditors.
  - (d) Loss of qualification for the office.
  - (e) Incapacity to act or absence from meetings continued for a period of three months without the leave of the body concerned.
  - (f) A resolution by the Synod or by the Standing Committee when the Synod is not in Session declaring a vacancy and specifying the person and one of the Ordinances Rules Regulations or Standing Orders mentioned in the Schedule and the reason therefor.
- 2. In all cases of persons elected or to be elected by Synod under any of the Ordinances Rules Regulations or Standing Orders mentioned in the schedule hereto casual vacancies may be filled ad interim by the Standing Committee of Synod when the Synod is not in Session.
- 3. The tenure of office of persons filling such casual vacancies shall be until the vacancy is filled at the next ensuing ordinary Session of Synod or in the case of failure by such Session of Synod until the vacancy is again filled by the Standing Committee or

some subsequent ordinary Session of Synod provided that the person appointed or elected to fill the casual vacancy shall cease to hold office at the time at which the person who filled the office immediately before the casual vacancy occurred would have ceased to hold office if the casual vacancy had not occurred without prejudice however to eligibility for re-election or reappointment.

- 4. The relative provisions of the Ordinances Rules Regulations or Standing Orders mentioned in the schedule hereto are hereby respectively superseded by the provisions of this Ordinance to the extent necessary to give effect thereto and all future Ordinances Rules Regulations or Standing Orders providing for the election or appointment to offices shall be deemed to contain the 1st 2nd and 3rd sections mutatis mutandis of this ordinance unless expressly excluded therefrom.
- 5. The provisions of the Elections Ordinance 1934 shall be deemed not to have applied and shall not apply to the appointment of a person for the purposes of the 26th Section of the Constitutions contained in the schedule to the Church of England Constitutions Act Amendment Act of 1902 and the 39th Section of the "Church of England Trust Property Act 1917."
- 6. This Ordinance may be cited as "Casual Vacancies Ordinance 1935."
