### Church Administration Ordinance 1990 Amendment Ordinance 2000

### Long Title

An Ordinance to amend the Church Administration Ordinance 1990.

The Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney Ordains as follows -

### 1. Name

This Ordinance is the Church Administration Ordinance 1990 Amendment Ordinance 2000.

### 2. Amendments

The Church Administration Ordinance 1990 is amended as follows -

- (a) a new paragraph 11(1)(fa) is inserted as follows -
- "(fa) to receive reports concerning ministry within the parish from -
- (i) the minister; and
- (ii) with the minister's consent a superintendent, teacher, leader or other officer appointed under subclause 43(1)."; and
- (b) a new paragraph 12(1)(fa) is inserted as follows -
- "(fa) to receive reports concerning ministry within the parish from -
- (i) the minister; and
- (ii) with the minister's consent a superintendent, teacher, leader or other officer appointed under subclause 43(1)."; and
- (c) insert a new clause 38A as follows -

# "38A. Resolutions of the Parish Council without a meeting

- (1) The members of a parish council may pass a resolution without a meeting of the parish council being held if all the members entitled to vote on the resolution sign a document containing a statement that they are in favour of the resolution set out in the document.
- (2) Separate copies of a document may be used for signing by members if the wording of the resolution and statement is identical in each copy.
- (3) The resolution is passed when the last member signs.

- (4) The members must ensure
- (a) each resolution passed under this clause without a meeting is recorded in the minute book of the parish council within 1 month; and
- (b) the passing of the resolution is noted at the next meeting of the parish council.".
