

THE CHURCH OF ENGLAND HOMES ORDINANCE 1984

WHEREAS it is expedient to make provision for the membership functions and administrative powers of the body corporate known as The Committee of the Church of England Homes NOW the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of such Synod HEREBY ORDAINS DIRECTS AND RULES as follows:

PART I

Title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Church of England Homes Ordinance 1984".

PART II

Membership of the Committee of the
Church of England Homes

2. The members from time to time of the Council of The Sydney Anglican Home Mission Society (hereinafter called "the Council") shall ex officio be the members of The Committee of the Church of England Homes (hereinafter called "the Homes").

PART III
Powers

3. The members of the Homes shall have the same powers and obligations in respect of the property and assets of the Homes and its administration as are conferred or imposed on the Council in respect of the property and assets of The Sydney Anglican Home Mission Society and its administration by clauses 10 to 17 inclusive of The Sydney Anglican Home Mission Society Ordinance 1981.
