Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Sydney Ordinance 1932.

No. 8, 1932.

AN ORDINANCE to provide for the delegation of the powers and functions conferred by Sections 11 and 12 of the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917.

WHEREAS it is expedient to make a delegation to the Standing Committee as hereinafter expressed Now the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales and by the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 and of all other powers thereunto enabling it ordains directs and rules as follows:—

- 1. The Standing Committee is hereby appointed for the purpose of exercising and accordingly may during the recess of the Synod of the Diocese exercise in place of such Synod all or any of the powers and functions and do and make all or any of the things referred to in Sections 11 and 12 part 3 of the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917.
- 2. This Ordinance shall be styled and cited as the "Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Sydney Ordinance 1932."
