## No. 18, 1950

AN ORDINANCE to provide for certain Clergymen of the Diocese of Sydney becoming members of the Clergy Provident Fund (Sydney).

The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney ordains directs and rules as follows:--

- 1. Every Clergyman upon being licensed for the first time to a Parish or to a permanent office in the Diocese of Sydney after the date on which this Ordinance shall come into operation shall with the approval of the Board of Directors of the Clergy Provident Fund (Sydney) under the Clergy Provident Fund (Sydney) Ordinance 1944 or any Ordinance amending or taking the place of the same become and continue to be a member of and subscriber to the Clergy Provident Fund (Sydney) for Superannuation Annuity under the said Ordinance from the date of his licence and if married or on marriage he shall also with the like approval become and continue to be a subscriber to the said Fund for Widows' and Orphans' pensions under the said Ordinance from the date of his licence or marriage as the case may be, Provided that the Archbishop may exempt any such Clergyman from all or any port of this clause.
- 2. Every Clergyman who is licensed to a Parish or to a permanent office in the Diocese of Sydney who is not at the date on which this Ordinance shall come into operation a member of and subscriber to the Clergy Provident Fund (Sydney) for superanuation annuity under the said Ordinance shall within twelve months of the said date with the approval of the said Board of Directors become and continue to be a subscriber to the said fund and if married or on marriage shall also within the said time with the like approval become and continue to be a subscriber to the said fund for Widows' and Orphans' pensions under the said Ordinance provided that the Archbishop may exempt any such clergyman from all or part of the provisions of this clause or extend the time within which he shall become a member of and subscriber to the said Fund.
- 3. This Ordinance shall be styled and cited as "Clergy Provident Fund (Sydney) Membership Ordinance 1950."
