AN ORDINANCE to authorise the incorporation of "The Committee of The Church of England Homes" as a body corporate pursuant to the Provisions of the "Church of England (Bodies Corporate) Act, 1938."

WHEREAS by "The Church of England Homes Constitution Ordinance 1930" the Synod of the Church of England in the Diocese of Sydney approved the amalgamation of the Societies theretofore existing and known respectively as The Church of England Homes and The Church of England Committee for Homes and Hostels for Children and the constitution of the amal'amated society known as The Church of England Homes (hereinafter called the said Society) set forth in the schedule to such ordinance was thereby ratified and confirmed and by such ordinance it was declared that the said Society should be thenceforth managed and conducted pursuant to the said constitution. AND WHEREAS the management conduct and control of the said Society is by the said Constitution vested in /a committee which is an unincorporated body. AND WHEREAS it is expedient for the purpose of managing governing or controlling the said society that the persons who for the time being are the members of the committee thereof should be constituted a body corporate pursuant to the provisions of the "Church of England (Bodies Corporate) Act 1938." Now the Synod of the Church of England in the, Diocese of Sydney hereby ordains declares directs and rules as follows:-

1. The Synod hereby declares that it is expedient for the purpose of managing governing or controlling The Church of England Homes that the persons who for the time being are the members of the unincorporated body of the Committee of The Church of England Homes should be constituted a body corporate under the name of "The Committee of The Church of England Homes."

2. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Committee of The Church of England Homes Incorporation Ordinance 1944."
