
Diocesan Income and Expenditure Ordinance, 1970

No. 38, 1970

AN ORDINANCE to assess Parishes, Provisional Parishes and Provisional Districts pursuant to the provisions of the General Assessment Authorisation Ordinance, 1959, as amended, to further amend the Special Purposes Assessment Ordinance, 1958, to provide for the application of money remitted to Standing Committee pursuant to the provisions of Glebe Administration Ordinance, 1930-1967 Further Amendment Ordinance, 1967, and for purposes incidental to all or any of the above.

WHEREAS by or under the provisions of the General Assessment Authorisation Ordinance 1959 as amended provision is made for Standing Committee to prepare estimates and a statement showing the sums to be contributed by each Parish, Provisional Parish and Provisional District for the purposes set out therein based on an assessment in the manner provided by the said Ordinance AND WHEREAS it is expedient to fix an assessment for the period of one year commencing on the first day of April, 1971, AND WHEREAS it is expedient to continue the provisions of the Special Purposes Assessment Ordinance 1958 as amended, subject to certain amendments as hereinafter provided and to fix an assessment in pursuance thereof for one year to take effect from the first day of April 1971, AND WHEREAS the Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930-1970 provides that Synod shall from time to time by Ordinance determine in what manner and for what purposes the amount remitted to Standing Committee by the Glebe Administration Board shall be applied NOW the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney HEREBY ORDAINS DECLARES DIRECTS AND RULES as follows:—

1. The Estimates comprising the first schedule to this Ordinance are hereby approved.
2. (a) Synod hereby fixes an amount of \$206,714 as an assessment under the General Assessment Authorisation Ordinance 1959 as amended for the period of one year from the first day of April, 1971 to the 31st day of March, 1972 in accordance with the details set out in the Second Schedule hereto.
(b) the said assessment shall operate in accordance with the provisions of the General Assessment Authorisation Ordinance 1959 as amended.
3. (a) The Special Purposes Assessment Ordinance 1958 as amended is hereby further amended by suspending so much of the provisions of such ordinance as are inconsistent with this Ordinance and by
 - (i) Fixing an assessment for the purposes referred to in such ordinance for one year from first day of April, 1971, to 31st day of March, 1972; and
 - (ii) Deleting the Second Schedule thereto and inserting

in its place the estimates of Section B of the First Schedule of this Ordinance.

- (b) Synod hereby fixes an amount of \$46,832 as an assessment for the period of one year from 1st day of April, 1971 to the 31st day of March, 1972 in accordance with the details set out in the Second Schedule of this Ordinance, and the Third Schedule of the Special Purposes Assessment Ordinance 1958 is amended accordingly.
4. Synod hereby directs that the moneys remitted to Standing Committee in accordance with the provisions of Clause 14 (ii) of the Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930-1970 shall be applied as income for the Special Purposes Ordinance for the purposes of Section B of the First Schedule of this Ordinance.
 5. Nothing contained in this Ordinance shall in any way alter the provisions in respect of payment of assessments by any parish contained in the Presentation and Exchange Ordinance 1933-1969 and any amendment thereof.
 6. This Ordinance may be cited as "Diocesan Income and Expenditure Ordinance 1970".
