Diocesan Mission (Funding) Ordinance 2006

No 15, 2006

Long Title

An Ordinance to provide for the application of certain property for the purposes of the Diocesan Mission.

Preamble

- A. Glebe Administration Board holds certain property (the "Property") on trust for the purposes of the Anglican Church of Australia in the Diocese of Sydney under clause 3 of the Diocesan Endowment Ordinance 1984.
- B. The Synod of the Diocese has adopted the following Mission Statement -
 - "To glorify God by proclaiming our Saviour the Lord Jesus Christ in prayerful dependence on the Holy Spirit, so that everyone will hear his call to repent, trust and serve Christ in love, and be established in the fellowship of his disciples while they await his return."
- C. It is expedient to appropriate a sum of up to \$500,000 from the Property to be applied for the purposes of the Mission.

The Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney Ordains as follows.

1. Name

This Ordinance is the Diocesan Mission (Funding) Ordinance 2006.

2. Direction for payment

Glebe Administration Board is to apply up to \$500,000 from the Property for the purposes of the costs of the employment or appointment of a Diocesan Mission Officer and all costs incidental thereto for the period until 31 December 2008.
