An Ordinance to amend the Diocesan Missions Ordinance of 1927.

The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England in the State of New South Wales and by the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 and of all other powers thereunto enabling it ordains directs and declares as follows:—

- 1. The "Diocesan Missions Ordinance of 1927" is hereby amended as follows:—
 - (a) In Section 2 by inserting immediately after "(d)" the words "to provide for the payment of the stipends and expenses of such missioner or missioners and (e)."

(b) In Section 3 by omitting "nine" and inserting in its place "lifteen"

- (c) In Section 5 by omitting "six" and inserting in its place "ten" and by omitting "three" and inserting in its place "five."
- (d) In Section 6 by omitting "four" and inserting in its place "six."
- (e) In Section 7 by inserting "additional" immediately before "members" and by inserting "required to constitute the enlarged Board" immediately after "members."
- 2. This Ordinance may be cited as "Diocesan Missions Ordinance Amending Ordinance of 1942."
