

Diocesan Officers (Retirement) Repeal Ordinance 2001

No 59, 2001

An Ordinance to repeal the Diocesan Officers (Retirement) Ordinance 1987 and provisions of other ordinances which require the holders of certain offices to retire at the age of 72 years or make persons of or above the age of 72 years ineligible for appointment to such offices.

1. Name of Ordinance

This Ordinance is the Diocesan Officers (Retirement) Repeal Ordinance 2001.

2. Repeal

The Diocesan Officers (Retirement) Ordinance 1987 is repealed.

3. (1) This clause applies to the office of a member of a board, chapter, committee, corporation, council or other body constituted, or controlled or regulated, by ordinance of the Synod or the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney but does not apply to an office to which the Retirements Ordinance 1993 applies.

(2) Any provision of an ordinance that -

- (a) requires the holder of an office to which this clause applies to retire at the age of 72 years, or
- (b) provides that a person of or above the age of 72 years is not eligible to be appointed or elected to or to act in an office to which this clause applies,

is, to the extent to which it makes that requirement or provision, repealed.

4. Authority to amend other Ordinances

Where the provisions of an ordinance applying to an office to which clause 3 of this Ordinance applies are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, the Diocesan Secretary is empowered and authorised, on the reprinting of the ordinance, to make such amendments to it as will remove the inconsistency.
