AN ORDINANCE for accepting and adopting a certain Determination of the General Synod, Session 1900, intituled, "Rule to provide for the election of the Bishop of New Guinea."

Assented to 5 October, 1900)

Whereas a certain Determination being Determination No. II. was made by the General Synod of the Dioceses in Australia and Tasmania, on the third day of September, 1900, intituled "Rule to provide for the election of the Bishop of New Guinea," a copy of which is contained in the Schedule annexed to this Ordinance. And whereas it is expedient that the said Determination shall be accepted by the Church in this Diocese. The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney, in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the United Church of England and Ireland within the Colony of New South Wales, ordains and rules as follows:—

That the said Determination and the Rules therein contained, and each and every of them shall be, and the same are and is hereby accepted and adopted, and shall so far as the same are applicable be applied to the management and government of the Church in this Diocese in like manner as if the said Determination, and the Rules therein contained, and each and every of them had brell ordained and ruled by the Synod of this Diocese.
