An Ordinance to render perpetual an Ordinance of the Fourth Session of the Second Synod No. V, and entituled "An Ordinance to provide for the election of Bishops to the See of Sydney."

WHEREAS it is expedient to render perpetual the Ordinance No. V., passed on the nineteenth day of June, 1873, and entituled "An Ordinance to provide for the election of Bishops to the See of Sydney." The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the United Church of England and Ireland

within the Colony of New South Wales and of all powers vested in the

Ordinance for Election of Bishops perpetual.

The Ordinance passed in the Fourth Session of the Second Synod, No. V, intituled "An Ordinance to provide for the election of Bishops to the See of Sydney," is hereby made perpetual.
