

Five Dock/Haberfield Ordinance 1999 Amendment Ordinance 2000

No 37, 2000

Long Title

An Ordinance to authorise the payment of funds from the capital amount towards property renovations.

Preamble

A. The Anglican Church Property Trust Diocese of Sydney (the "Property Trust") holds funds arising out of the Haberfield Land Sale Ordinance 1995.

B. By the Five Dock/Haberfield Ordinance 1999 ("the Principal Ordinance") provision was made for certain sums to be paid from the proceeds of sale and for the balance to be invested.

C. By reason of circumstances which have arisen after the creation of the trusts on which the funds are held it is inexpedient to carry out and observe the same to the extent that the same are hereby varied.

The Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney Ordains as follows -

1. Name

This Ordinance is the Five Dock/Haberfield Ordinance 1999 Amendment Ordinance 2000.

2. Declarations

By reason of circumstances which have arisen after the creation of the trusts on which the funds are held it is inexpedient to carry out and observe the same to the extent that the same are hereby varied.

3. Amendment

The Principal Ordinance is amended as follows -

- (a) insert the following paragraph after clause 3(c) -
 - "(d) a sum of \$20,000 to be paid to the Sydney Church of England Finance and Loans Board to repay a loan (and interest thereon) taken out for the purposes of expenditure of the parish residence known as 1B Henry Street Five Dock;"; and
- (b) delete the matter "(d)" in existing clause 3(d) and insert instead the matter "(e)".
