# Proposal to Change the Assisted Provisional Parish of Georges Hall to a Provisional Parish

(A report from the Standing Committee.)

#### **Initiation of Proposal**

- 1. The proposal was made to the Archbishop by the Minister and Churchwardens of St Martin's Church, Georges Hall.
- 2. The requirements of the Parishes Ordinance have been complied with.

## **Details of the Meeting**

3. A meeting of the Permanent Investigation Committee was held on 21 June 1996 to consider the proposal under clause 5 of the Parishes Ordinance when the following persons were present -

Permanent Investigation Committee: Archdeacon R.T. Platt (Chairman),Mr W.G.S. Gotley, Archdeacon G.R. Huard, the Rev P.J. Tasker.

## The Proposal

- 4. The proposal is to change the Assisted Provisional Parish of Georges Hall to a Provisional Parish from 1 November 1996.
- 5. Georges Hall was declared a new housing district in November 1977 from territory which was formerly part of the Parish of Yagoona.
- 6. The Rev T.D. Filewood was appointed curate in charge on 9 February 1996. There were 2 acting curates in charge at different times in 1995.

#### **Parish Information**

- 7. The 1991 Census revealed a population of 9,582 of whom 24% are Anglicans.
- 8. Services are conducted at 9 am and 7 pm on Sundays and average attendances of the 2 services combined are as follows:
