An Ordinance to amend and supplant the Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930 as amended.

WHEREAS by the Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930 (No. 15, 1930) the rents issues and profits of St. James' Glebe were directed to be applied as from 31st December, 1930 as set out in Clause 15 thereof AND WHEREAS Sub-clauses (a) (b) and (c) of such Clause provide for certain specific application of such rents issues and profits and Sub-clause (d) for the remainder to be applied for such purposes as shall be determined by Synod And WHEREAS by Church of England (Bodies Corporate) Act 1938 Delegation of Powers Ordinance 1961 the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney appointed the Standing Committee of the said Synod as the Committee to exercise from time to time during the recess of Synod the functions of the Synod conferred upon it by the Church of England (Bodies Corporate) Act 1938 And whereas it is expedient that certain moneys forming part of the unappropriated rents issues and profits of St. James' Glebe now held to the extent of a sum not exceeding Two thousand pounds (£2,000) be paid and applied as hereinafter set out NOW the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod HEREBY ORDAINS RULES AND DIRECTS as follows:-

- 1. That the sum of Two thousand pounds (£2,000) be paid out of the unappropriated residue of the rents issues and profits of St. James' Glebe now held for the restoration of the fabric of historic churches of the Church of England in the Diocese of Sydney including St. Matthew's Church Windsor to be applied in such amounts as the Standing Committee may by resolution determine.
- 2. This Ordinance may be cited as "Glebe Administration Amendment Ordinance 1963."
