Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930-1965 Further Amendment Ordinance 1966

No. 17, 1966.

AN ORDINANCE to amend further the "Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930-1965" and for purposes connected therewith.

Whereas by the Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930-1965 provision is made by Clause 15 thereof to apply the rents issues and profits of the St. James' Glebe in a certain manner and as to the remainder of the rents issues and profits for such purposes as shall be determined by Synod And whereas it is expedient to apply portion of the said remainder for or towards the purposes and to the extent hereafter set out NOW therefore the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod and by virtue of the powers vested in it pursuant to the Church of England (Bodies Corporate) Act 1938 Delegation of Powers Ordinance 1961 and all other powers thereunte enabling it HEREBY ORDAINS RULES AND DIRECTS as follows:-

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as "Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930-1965 Further Amendment Ordinance 1966."
- 2. The "Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930-1965" is in this Ordinance referred to as "the principal Ordinance."
- 3. The Principal Ordinance as amended by Ordinance No. 16, 1966 and by this Ordinance may be cited as "Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930-1966."
- 4. Clause 15 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting the following additional sub-clause after sub-clause (c).
 - (c-1) In satisfying so much of the amounts charged by Clause 14 (2) upon the rents issues and profits of St. Philip's Glebe as in the opinion of the Board is expedient in any one year.
