Whereas Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Sydney (hereinafter called the Corporate Trustee) is registered as proprietor of the land comprised in Certificate of Title Volume 4755 Folio 134 more particularly described in the Schedule hereto And Whereas the said land is Church Trust Property and is held upon trust for the Home Mission Society Diocese of Sydney as constituted by "The Home Mission Society Ordinance of 1911" And Whereas by reason of circumstances which have arisen subsequent to the creation of the Trusts upon which the said land is held it is inexpedient to carry out and observe the same and it is expedient that the said land be sold NOW the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod ordains and directs as follows:—

- By reason of circumstances which have arisen subsequent to the creation of the Trusts upon which the land described in the Schedule hereto is held it is inexpedient to carry out and observe the same and it is expedient that the said land be sold.
- The said land may be sold by Public Auction or Private Contract at such time and upon such terms and conditions as the Corporate Trustee shall think fit, freed from the trusts on which it is now held.
- 3. The proceeds of any sale hereby authorised shall be applied by the Corporate Trustee as follows:—
  - (a) In payment of the costs and expenses of and incidental to this Ordinance and such sale and transfer executed in pursuance thereof and any charges and or outgoings to which the said land may be subject.
  - (b) Subject thereto the balance shall be paid to the Home Mission Society which shall apply such money in terms of the Home Mission Society Ordinance of 1911.
- 4. This Ordinance may be styled and cited as "The Home Mission Society (21 Clements Street Five Dock) Sale Ordinance 1961."
