Incapacity and Inefficiency Further Amendment 1924.

AN ORDINANCE to further amend the "Incapacity and Inefficiency Ordinance, 1906."

Whereas it is expedient to further amend the "Incapacity and Inefficiency Ordinance 1906" The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the "Church of England Constitutions Act Amendment Act of 1902" and of all other powers vested in the said Synod ordains and rules as follows:—

- * 1. Section 5 of the "Incapacity and Inefficiency Ordinance 1906" is hereby amended by the omission of the following words from such section, "that in all cases the Bishop shall be satisfied that an adequate provision exists or has been made for a retiring allowance or annuity to the Clergyman Provided further—"
- 2. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Incapacity and Inefficiency Further Amendment Ordinance 1924."
