AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 18 of the Ordinance passed on the 3rd October, 1918, to regulate the procedure in the initiation of Ordinances under the "Church of England Trust Property Act, 1917" (No. 21) and to delegate certain powers and functions in pursuance of the provisions of the said Act.

The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales and by the "Church of England Trust Property Act 1917" (No. 21) and of all other powers thereunto enabling it ordains declares determines directs and rules as follows:—

- 1. Section 18 of the Ordinance passed on the 3rd October, 1918, to regulate the procedure in the initiation of Ordinances under the "Church of England Trust Property Act 1917" (No. 21) and to delegate certain powers and functions in pursuance of the provisions of the said Act is hereby amended as follows:
 - (a) By inserting therein immediately after "Part VI." the words and figures following namely:—"and section 32 constituting Part VII."
 - (b) By adding thereto the following proviso, namely:— "Provided that any Ordinance proposed to be made by the Standing Committee partly or wholly under the powers conferred by the said Section 32 constituting Part VII. of the said Act may at any stage before assent thereto be referred to the Synod of the Diocese by the person for the time being authorised to assent to an Ordinance of such Synod and such person shall refer

such Ordinance to such Synod upon the request in writing of any three members of the Standing Committee presented to such person before such assent."
