ORDINANCE. MANLY SUPPLEMENTAL.

AN ORDINANCE to amend and supplement the St. Matthew's Manly Sale Ordinance of 1910 and the St. Matthew's Manly Sale Ordinance Supplemental Ordinance of 1915.

WHEREAS by the St. Matthew's Manly Sale Ordinance of 1910 it was provided that the lands mentioned in the Schedule thereto should be sold and that the proceeds of sale should be. applied for the purposes mentioned in the said Ordinance and inter alia for the purpose of discharging all existing Charch Rectory School-house and Organ liabilities not exceeding the sum of One thousand pounds. AND WHEREAS by Section 7 of the said Ordinance it was provided that the said proceeds of sale or any part thereof might be applied in lieu of the said purposes to such other purposes as might thereafter from time to time be determined by the Synod. AND WHEREAS at the time of the passing of the said Ordinance (hereinafter called the Ordinance of 1910) portion of the said liabilities consisted of certain principal and interest moneys due and owing to the Centennial Church Extension Fund and there is still due and owing the sum of Two hundred and seventy pounds on account of such principal moneys and a sum of about Fifty pounds on account of such interest. AND WHEREAS by the St. Matthew's Manly Sale Ordinance Supplemental Ordinance of 1915 (hereinafter called the Ordinance of 1915) it was provided that the lands described in the Second Schedule thereto (being part of the land described in the Ordinance of 1910) might be leased and that the rents arising therefrom should be applied as in the said Ordinance of 1915 more particularly set forth and that the proceeds of sale of the land described in the Second Schedule should be applied as might thereafter be determined by the Synod but that the proceeds of sale of the land described in the Third Schedule to the Ordinance of 1915 (being the remainder of the lands described in the Ordinance of 1910) should in lieu of the purposes mentioned in Sections 4\15 and 6 of the Ordinance of 1910 be applied for the purposes and in the manner more particularly set forth in the now reciting ordinance. AND WHEREAS uncertainty exists as to how and when the liability to the Centennial Church Extension Fund will be liquidated and it is expedient to make more certain provision in that behalf. Now the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England in the State of New South Wales and of all powers vested in it by the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 or otherwise ordains directs and rules as follows:—

1. Section 3 of the said Ordinance of 1915 shall be amended by inserting after the word "Manly" where it first appears therein the following words:—

"and to the extent of Fifty pounds per annum in paying "the same by equal quarterly payments to the Treasurer "for the time being of the Centennal Church Extension "Fund to be applied in reduction of the principal and "interest moneys for the time being owing to that Fund "by the Parish of St. Matthew's Manly and the costs "charges and expenses of and incidental to this Ordi"nance, provided that such quarterly payments shall be "applied in the first instance towards the said costs "charges and expenses and in the next place towards "the interest for the time being owing and that the "balance shall be applied in reduction of the said prin"cipal moneys,"

- 2. Section 4 of the Ordinance of 1915 shall be amended by inserting immediately before sub-section (a) the following sub-section:—
 - "(aa.) In discharge of all moneys for the time being owing "to the said Centennial Church Extension Fund by the "said Parish as aforesaid to which shall be added the "costs charges and expenses of and incidental to this "Ordinance."
 - "(a) (b) In restoration to the proper persons for the purposes "mentioned in Section 3 (a) (b) and (c) of the said "Ordinance of 1915 of the said capital amount of £270 "or so much thereof as shall have been paid out of rents "under the provisions of this Ordinance and also in "paying other liabilities referred to in Section 4 (a) of "the said Ordinance of 1910 not exceeding with the said "sum of £270 the aggregate amount of £1000."

3. This Ordinance may be cited as "The St. Matthew's Manly Supplemental Ordinance of 1919."
