- 2. (1) By reason of circumstances which have arisen subsequent to the creation of the trusts on which the properties described in the Third Schedule hereto are held it is inexpedient to carry cut and observe the same and it is expedient that the same be sold.
 - (2) The said trustees are hereby authorised to sell such of the properties described in the Third Schedule hereto as the said Committee may decide (whether before or after the date on which assent is given to this ordinance) should be sold and to sell the same by public auction or by private treaty, for such price and on and subject to such terms and conditions as, to the said trustees, may seem appropriate.
 - (3) The proceeds from the sale of each of the said properties shall be applied in meeting all costs in connection with such sale and the balance then remaining shall be applied in or towards either or both of the following:-
 - (a) the payment of the purchase price payable for the property described in the First Schedule hereto,
 - (b) the repayment of moneys borrowed to pay the said purchase price.
- 3. This ordinance may be cited as "Moore College Sale Ordinance 1980".
