AN ORDINANCE to authorise the sale of land at the vary trusts Mt Druitt (St. Johns) and the application of the proceeds towards costs of erection of buildings on another site.

## WHEREAS

What By

A. The Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Sydney (now known as Anglican Church Property Trust Diocese of Sydney)
(herainafter called "the corporate trustee") is registered as proprietor in fee simple of the lands described in the Schedule.

New regital. "De The corporate trustee holds a sum of money being the proceeds of sale pursuant to the Mt. Druitt Land Sale Ordinance 1981 on trust for the costs of repair renovation and extensions to the church of St. John Mt. Druitt.

A. The lands are held upon trust for the parish of Mt. Druitt but no trusts have been declared in writing.

NOW the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod HEREBY ORDAINS DECLARES DIRECTS AND RULES as follows:

- 1. By reason of circumstances which have arisen subsequent to the creation of the trusts upon which the lands described are held it is inexpedient to carry out and observe the same and it is expedient that the lands be sold.
- 2. The corporate trustee is hereby authorised and empowered to sell the lands within three years after the date of assent to this Ordinance and thereafter only with the consent of the Standing Committee by public auction or private contract at such time and at such price and upon such terms and conditions as it may determine freed from the trusts upon which they are held.
  - 3. The proceeds arising from the sale shall be applied as follows:
    - (a) Firstly to pay all outgoings to which the lands may be subject, the costs of and incidental to this Ordinance and the sale pursuant thereto.

(b) Secondly the net balance shall be applied towards the cost of erecting, fitting out and furnishing buildings for use as a church, parsonage or parish hall or partly for one and partly for another of such purposes in connection with the Anglican Church of Australia in the Parish of Mt. Druitt or in any other parish into which it may subsequently be formed.

New elanse. "4. By reason of circumstances which have arisen subsequent to the creation of the trusts upon which the said money is held it is inexpedient to carry out and observe the same and it is expedient that the said money be held on the trusts set out in clause 3(b)).

Y. This ordinance may be cited as "Mt. Druitt (St. Johns) Sale Ordinance 1984".

## SCHEDULE

ALL THOSE lands at Mt. Druitt being Lot 14 of Section G and being the whole of the land comprised in Certificate of Title Volume 2063 Folio 185 and all the land comprised in Certificate of Title Volume 2669 Folio 192.
