## Naremburn Mission District.

AN ORDINANCE to form a Mission District to be known as Naremburn and so far as may be necessary for such purposes to amend "The Parishes and Mission Districts Ordinance of 1902."

WHEREAS it is expedient to form a Mission District to be known as Naremburn. The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales ordains and rules as follows:—

- 1. A Mission District to be known as Naremburn is hereby formed within the boundaries set forth in the Schedule hereto.
- 2. The said Mission District shall be a Mission District in all respects the same as if it had been formed in accordance with the provisions of "The Parishes and Mission Districts Ordinance of 1902."
- 3. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Naremburn Mission District Formation Ordinance 1912."

## SCHEDULE.

Commencing at the railway where the head waters of Flat Rock Creek begin to drain near Punch Street thence following Flat Rock Creek the South Side to West Street thence by West Street to Holterman Street excluding thereout the Cemetery known as St. Thomas' Cemetery thence by Holterman Street to Willoughby Road thence by Willoughby Road to Clarke Street thence by Clarke Street to Hume Street thence by Hume Street to Fleming Street thence by Eastern side of the Railway line to point of starting as shown upon a map deposited in the Sydney Diocesan Registry.
