Proposal to Change the Assisted Provisional Parish of Oakhurst to a Provisional Parish

(A Report from the Parramatta Regional Council)

Initiation of Proposal

1. The proposal is to change the Assisted Provisional Parish of Oakhurst to a Provisional Parish from 1 January 1998. It was considered by the Parramatta Regional Council on 17 June 1997.

Parish Information

- 2. Formerly the branch church of the Parish of Rooty Hill, known as St Mark's Plumpton. Oakhurst was declared an APP in 1987 following large housing development of Plumpton.
- 3. The Rev Allen Cook the third Curate in Charge, appointed in 1995, following the Revs L.M. Stoddart and the late W. Gott.
- 4. Australia Post records indicate that there are just on 6,000 homes and Blacktown City Council research indicates there are 4.4 residents per household. Anglican numbers are unknown.
- 5. Services conducted at St Mark's are 8.30 am, 10.00 am and 6.30 pm each Sunday, with plans to start a seeker type service on Saturday evenings from August/September 1997. The figures given below shows overall average attendance.
