TITLE.

An Ordinance to amend "The Cathedral Ordinance of 1868."

PREAMBLE.

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend the Cathedral Ordinance of 1868: The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the United Church of England and Ireland within the Colony of New South Wales ordains and rules as follows:—

1. Whenever the office of Chancellor of the Diocese shall be held by one of the Canons appointed or elected under the Cathedral Ordinance of 1868 the Chapter shall during such tenure of office of Chancellor by a Canon consist of fourteen members namely the Bishop of the Diocese for the time being the Dean of Sydney for the time being ap-

pointed by the Bishop the six Canons appointed and elected under the Cathedral Ordinance of 1868 including such Canon holding office as Chancellor and six Laymen as mentioned in the Seventh Section of the said Cathedral Ordinance and such Chapter consisting of fourteen members shall have and exercise all the rights powers privileges and authorities conferred upon the Chapter as constituted under the Cathedral Ordinance of 1868.

2. The Ordinance may be cited as "The Cathedral Ordinance of 1868 Amendment Ordinance of 1876."
