Provincial Synod; acceptance of Ordinances, etc.

AN ORDINANCE for regulating the mode of accepting Ordinances and Determinations of Provincial Synod.

(Assented to 29 July 1886.)

Whereas by the "Constitution for the Provincial Synod of the Province of New South Wales," accepted and adopted by the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney on the twenty-third day of July, 1885, it is provided that the mode of accepting in any Diocese the Ordinances and Determinations of the said Provincial Synod shall be laid down by the Church in such Diocese. And whereas it is desirable to regulate the mode of accepting Ordinances and Determinations of the said Provincial Synod. The Synod of the said Diocese in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the United Church of England and Ireland within the Colony of New South Wales ordains and rules as follows:—

The mode of acceptance in the said Diocese of Sydney of Ordinances and Determinations of the said Provincial Synod shall be by Ordinance.
