An Ordinance to amend the Parishes and Mission Districts Ordinance of 1902.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend the Parishes and Mission Districts Ordinance of 1902.

The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within Nev South Wales ordains as follows.

I. Definitions.

"Principal Ordinance" means the Parishes and Mission Districts Ordinance of 1902.

In the Principal Ordinance and in this Ordinance "Archbishop" means the Archbishop of Sydney for the time being or a Commissary duly appointed by him or the Administrator of the Diocese as the case may be,

"Mission District" shall hereafter be designated as "Parochial District" and the words "Mission District" in the Principal or any other Ordinance shall be interpreted to mean "Parochial District."

The Minister in charge of a Parish may be known and designated as "Rector."

The Minister in Charge of a Parochial District may be known and designated as "Vicar,"

- 2. Clause 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting after the words "new Parishes," in Sub-clause 2 the words, "with a written description thereof,"
- 3. The first proviso of Clause 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by omitting all the words after "from" to the end of this sentence and inserting "Creating a Provisional District in any case of emergency until the provisions of this Ordinance can be complied with." In every such case the Archbishop shall report in writing to the Standing Committee at its next ensuing meeting what has been done.

4. This Ordinance shall be styled and cited as the (Parishes and Mission Districts Ordinance of 1902) Amendment Ordinance.
