An Ordinance to amend the Presentation and Exchange Ordinance 1933-58.

WHEREAS it is expedient to increase the minimum stipend to be provided for the Minister by a Parish before it shall have the right to elect representatives under the "Presentation and Exchange Ordinance 1933-58" NOW the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales ordains and rules as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Presentation and Exchange Amending Ordinance 1959".
- 2. (a) The "Presentation and Exchange Ordinance 1933-58" is in this Ordinance referred to as the "Principal Ordinance".
- (b) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the "Presentation and Exchange Ordinance 1933-59".
  - 3. The Principal Ordinance is amended as follows:— Sub-clause 1 of Clause 8 is amended by deleting from sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph (a) the figures "950" and by inserting in lieu thereof the figures "1050".
- 4. The amendment effected by Clause 3 of this Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of April, 1961.
  - 5. The Principal Ordinance is amended further as follows:—Sub-clause (1) of Clause (8) is amended by deleting from paragraph (d) the words and figures "on or before the 30th day of September in the preceding financial year" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "in accordance with the conditions of payment set out therein".

6. The amendment effected by Clause 5 of this Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of October, 1959.
