Presentation and Exchange Ordinance Amendment Ordinance, 1966

No. 33, 1966.

Whereas Clause 8 of the Presentation and Exchange Ordinance 1933-1961 as amended provides that a Parish shall have the right to elect representatives under that Ordinance for the purpose therein set out only if the conditions of such Clause have been fulfilled AND WIERRAS by Resolution 7 of the Ordinary Session of the Synod of 1965 it was agreed that the Stipends and Allowances Committee reappointed by Synod should "report its findings to Standing Committee for action" AND WIERRAS it is desirable to make provision for this decision of the Synod in the Principal Ordinance, the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England in Australia within the State of New South Wales and of all other powers vested in it ORDAINS AND RULES as follows:-

- 1. The Presentation and Exchange Ordinance 1933-1961 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the "Presentation and Exchange Ordinance 1933-1966."
 - 3. The Principal Ordinance is amended as follows:-

By deleting sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph (a) of subclause 1 of Clause 8 and inserting in its place the following:

"A stipend of at least the amount last recommended by resolution of Standing Committee or Synod as the minimum stipend payable to a Rector from local sources including any variations determined by such resolution during such financial year."
