

Robertson (Kangaloon and Glenquarry) Land Sale Ordinance 1993 Amendment Ordinance 1994

No 62, 1994

Long Title

An Ordinance to amend the Robertson (Kangaloon and Glenquarry) Land Sale Ordinance 1993.

Preamble

Whereas

A. Certain funds are church trust property held on the trusts specified in the Robertson (Kangaloon and Glenquarry) Land Sale Ordinance 1993 (the "Principal Ordinance").

B. The income from those funds is applied as follows -

- (a) 11% is paid to the parish for payments of assessments; and
- (b) the balance is capitalised.

C. By reason of circumstances arising after the creation of the trusts specified in the Principal Ordinance it is inexpedient to carry out and observe those trusts and it is expedient that those trusts be varied in the manner set out in this ordinance.

Now the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod Hereby Ordains Declares Directs and Rules as follows.

Citation

1. This ordinance may be cited as the "Robertson (Kangaloon and Glenquarry) Land Sale Ordinance 1993 Amendment Ordinance 1994"

Declaration of Inexpediency

2. By reason of circumstances arising after the creation of the trusts specified in the Principal Ordinance it is inexpedient to carry out and observe those trusts and it is expedient that those trusts be varied in the manner set out in this ordinance.

Amendment of the Principal Ordinance

3. The Principal Ordinance is amended by adding the following at the end of clause 5 -

"But on and from 1 October 1994 the income must be applied as follows -

- (c) if by reason of such income the assessments payable by the Parish are more than would otherwise have been payable if such income had not been earned, an amount equal to the amount of the excess must be paid to the churchwardens of St John's Church Robertson ("Churchwardens") to be applied toward payment of those assessments;
- (d) an amount equal to the lesser of -
 - (i) 50% of the income; and
 - (ii) the cost of providing rental accommodation for a full-time pastoral worker working in the Parish under the control of the minister,

shall be paid to the Churchwardens to be applied towards the cost of providing such rental accommodation but only for so long as such rental accommodation is required to be provided; and

- (e) the balance of the income, if any, must be capitalised."
