Sadleir Variation of Trusts Ordinance 1994

No 33,1994

Long Title

An Ordinance to vary the trusts on which certain funds are held by the churchwardens of St Mark's Church Sadleir.

Preamble

Whereas

- A. The churchwardens ("Churchwardens") of St Mark's Church Sadleir hold an amount of approximately \$10,000 under clause 4(b)(ii) of the Sadleir (Hinchinbrook) Land Sale Ordinance 1993.
- B. The amount is held on trust to be applied towards the renovation of the properties known as 3 Tunbridge Street, Busby and 1 Spica Street, Sadleir.
- C. By reason of circumstances which have arisen after the creation of the trusts on which amount referred to in A. is held it is inexpedient to carry out and observe those trusts and it is expedient that the trusts be varied in the manner set out in this ordinance.

Now the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod Hereby Ordains Declares Directs and Rules as follows.

Citation

1. This ordinance may be cited as the "Sadleir Variation of Trusts Ordinance 1994".

Declaration of Inexpediency

2. By reason of circumstances which have arisen after the trusts on which the amount referred to in A. is held it is inexpedient to carry out and observe those trusts and it is expedient to amend those trusts in the manner set out in this ordinance.

Variation of Trusts

3. The trusts on which the amount referred to in A. are held are varied to such an extent as is required to permit the Churchwardens to apply a sum not exceeding \$3,000 therefrom for the general purposes of the provisional parish of Sadleir.
