
*Special Purposes Assessment Ordinance Amendment
Ordinance, 1964*

No. 31, 1964.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Special Purposes Assessment Ordinance 1958 and to assess Parishes, Provisional Parishes and Provisional Districts to provide contributions authorised by the Special Purposes Assessment Ordinance 1958 as amended.

WHEREAS by the Special Purposes Assessment Ordinance 1958 (hereinafter called the "Principal Ordinance") provision was made to make one assessment to take the place of the several separate assessments authorised by the Ordinances set out in the first schedule to that Ordinance and also to provide funds for making or supplementing allowances to Retired Clergy and/or for such other purposes as might from time to time be determined AND WHEREAS other purposes have from time to time been included in the budgets determined in subsequent years AND WHEREAS it is expedient that notice be given to the Standing Committee of Synod prior to the 1st day of May in any year of the desire of any Diocesan Organisation to be included in the budget prepared by the Standing Committee for the allocation of the moneys raised by Special Assessment from time to time and to amend the Principal Ordinance accordingly AND WHEREAS it is also expedient to continue the provisions of the Principal Ordinance subject to certain amendments as hereinafter provided and to fix an assessment in pursuance thereof for the years 1st April 1965 to 31st March 1966 and 1st April 1966 to 31st March 1967 AND WHEREAS it is expedient to fix the assessment at Forty six thousand five hundred and sixty seven pounds (£46,567) to take effect from 1st April 1965 to 31st March 1966 and to fix a rate of assessment to take effect from 1st April 1966 to 31st March 1967 AND WHEREAS it is expedient to amend further the Principal Ordinance to authorise the said assessments NOW the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney ORDAINS AND DIRECTS as follows:-

I. The Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after Clause 9 thereof the following new clause:-

"9A. Any Diocesan Organisation desiring to participate in the moneys raised by the Assessment hereby authorised and to be included in the budget of estimated annual

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allocation in respect of each year commencing on or after the 1st day of April 1966 shall give notice in writing to the Standing Committee not later than the 30th day of April in the year preceding the financial year commencing on the 1st day of April thereafter and shall furnish with such notice sufficient particulars and reasons in support of its application for the consideration of Standing Committee."

2. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended further by suspending so much of the provisions thereof as are inconsistent with this Ordinance and by fixing assessments for the purposes referred to in such Ordinance for the two years from 1st April 1965 to 31st March 1966 and from 1st April to 31st March 1967 respectively.

3. The estimates which appear in the first schedule hereto are hereby approved and the second schedule of the Principal Ordinance is amended accordingly.

4. The Synod hereby fixes an amount of Forty six thousand five hundred sixty seven pounds (£46,567) as an assessment for the year 1st April 1965 to 31st March 1966 in accordance with the details set out in the second schedule hereto and the third schedule of the Principal Ordinance is amended accordingly.

5. The Synod hereby further fixes an assessment for the year 1st April 1966 to 31st March 1967 at the rate of Seven pounds (£7) per centum in respect of Parishes and at the rate of Three pounds ten shillings (£3 : 10 : 0) per centum in respect of Provisional Parishes and Provisional Districts on their respective assessable incomes for the year ending 31st March 1965 as determined in accordance with the Principal Ordinance for the period of one year from 1st April 1966 to 31st March 1967 subject to a rebate in the case of Parishes of Eighty pounds (£80) each and in the case of Provisional Parishes and Provisional Districts of Forty pounds (£40) each on the amount of such assessment. The amount so raised by such assessment shall be allocated for the year 1966/67 to the same bodies and for proportionate amounts as are allocated in the First Schedule for the year 1965/1966.
