Special Religious Education (Program Evaluation) Funding Ordinance 2013

No 14, 2013

Long Title

An Ordinance to fund the costs and expenses of and incidental to undertaking a professional evaluation of the Diocesan Special Religious Education Program.

Preamble

- A. The Sydney Diocesan Secretariat (the Secretariat) holds certain property on behalf of the Synod in a fund known as Parish Costs Recovery Fund 951 ("PCR Fund").
- B. The PCR Fund is church trust property held on trust for the purposes of the Diocese for application towards ministry costs and parochial network costs within the meaning of the Cost Recoveries Framework Ordinance 2006.
- C. By reason of circumstances which have arisen after the creation of the trusts on which the PCR Fund is held it is inexpedient to carry our or observe those trusts and it is expedient to vary those trusts.

The Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney Ordains as follows.

1. Name

This Ordinance is the Special Religious Education (Program Evaluation) Funding Ordinance 2013.

2. Declaration

By reason of circumstances which have arisen after the creation of the trusts on which the PCR Fund is held it is inexpedient to carry out or observe those trusts and it is expedient to vary those trusts to the extent necessary to make the payment referred to in clause 3.

3. Application

The Secretariat is to pay an amount or amounts from the PCR Fund up to a total amount determined from time to time by resolution of the Standing Committee for the purposes of meeting the costs and expenses of and incidental to undertaking a professional evaluation of the Diocesan SRE Program in 2013 in accordance with the written direction of a Committee appointed by the Standing Committee for this purpose.
