
The St. Alban's Five Dock Amendment Ordinance 1955.

No. 24, 1955.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the St. Alban's Five Dock Ordinance 1942 and for purposes connected therewith.

WHEREAS:

The St. Alban's Five Dock Ordinance 1942 (hereinafter called "the said Ordinance") was passed at a time when the Parish of St. Alban's Five Dock was under heavy financial obligation, to meet which certain financial arrangements were made, as appears from the said Ordinance, and in consequence thereof the exercise of certain of its normal parochial privileges and powers were suspended and varied to the extent set forth in the said Ordinance.

AND WHEREAS:

The said financial obligations have now been greatly reduced and provision has been made to satisfy completely the same in the near future, in consequence whereof it is now just and expedient that the said suspension and variation should be removed.

Now the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney ordains as follows:

1. Sections 12, 13 and 14 of the said Ordinance are hereby repealed.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as "The St. Alban's Five Dock Amendment Ordinance 1955."
