No. 25, 1939.

AN ORDINANCE to authorise the mortgaging of certain lands situated at Strathfield in the County of Cumberland Parish of Concord and Municipality of Strathfield and to provide for the application of the proceeds thereof.

WHEREAS the lands mentioned in the Schedule hereunder (hereinafter called the said lands) are vested in Charles Cadell Capper William Gordon Nisbet and William Edwards as Trustees Upon Trust for the erection and maintenance thereon of a church or building to be known by the name of St. Anne and also to crect thereon or some part thereof a Church of England School and Parsonage or Residence for the Minister for the time being of the said Church or either of the said last mentioned buildings as might be determined by the Minister, the Trustees and the Wardens of the said church or the majority of them.

AND WHEREAS the said lands are Church Trust property.

AND WHERFAS it is expedient to declare the trusts in respect to the said lands as hereinafter mentioned.

AND WHEREAS there is at present erected on portion of the said lands the said Church of St. Anne Strathfield with Homebush which is consecrated and a Parish Hall.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to enlarge and renovate the said Parish Hall.

AND WHEREAS by reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the aforesaid trusts it has become inexpedient to carry out and observe such trusts insofar as the same are hereby varied Now the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod Ordains and Declares as follows:—

1. By reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the said trusts it has become inexpedient to carry out and observe such trusts insofar as the same are hereby varied and it is expedient that such trusts be varied accordingly.

- 2. The whole of the said lands shall be held Upon Trust to permit the same to be used for a Church and Church of England School or Parish Hall or partly for one or partly for another or others of such purposes in connection with the Church of England in the Parish of St. Anne Strathfield with Homebush.
- 3. So much of the said lands as the Archbishop shall certify are not required for the purpose of the said Church may be mortgaged for the purposes of borrowing the sums following:—
 - (a) When the power is first exercised a sum not exceeding Two thousand pounds (£2000).
 - (b) When the power is subsequently exercised such sum as the Standing Committee shall by resolution determine Provided that such debt shall be reduced at the rate of Fifty pounds (£50) per annum after the power is subsequently exercised.
 - (c) Any renewal of a mortgage shall be deemed to be a subsequent exercise of the said power.
 - (d) A document purporting to be certified by the Archbishop or Diocesan Secretary of the said Diocese as a copy of any such resolution shall in favour of a mortgagee or any person or corporation claiming under the mortgagee be conclusive evidence that such resolution was duly passed.
- 4. The proceeds of any mortgage authorised by Section 3 shall stand charged with the payment of the costs charges and expenses of and incidental to this Ordinance and such Mortgage and subject thereto such proceeds shall be applied in and towards the cost of enlarging and renovating the said Parish Hall.
- 5. The Churchwardens for the time being of St. Anne's Church Strathfield with Homebush shall within seven days of the date of holding the annual vestry meeting during such time as any money is owing to any Mortgagee pursuant to this Ordinance cause an account to be forwarded to the Diocesan Secretary giving details of the original amount borrowed amounts paid off and balance owing.
- 6. This Ordinance may be cited as "St. Anne's Strathfield with Homebush Mortgaging Ordinance 1939,"
