AN ORDINANCE to vary an Ordinance known as "St. Bartholomew's Pyrmont Land Resumption Ordinance 1925."

WHEREAS by an Ordinance passed by the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney and assented to on the 27th day of April 1925 it was provided that the resumption moneys therein referred to should be expended and invested in the manner therein mentioned AND WHEREAS by Section 4 of such Ordinance it is provided that out of the said compensation moneys such an amount should be paid to an therein mentioned as should Ъe necessary to Building Contractor progress payments to the Architect and for other purposes in connection with the erection of certain buildings the total cost of such buildings not to exceed £5500 AND WHEREAS by the Ordinance now in recital it was also provided that after payment of the moneys therein referred to ten per centum of the balance of the said compensation moneys should be paid to the Treasurer of the Church Buildings Loan Fund for use in aid of the objects of the said Fund and the ultimate balance of such compensation moneys should be invested and the income therefrom applied as AND WHEREAS since the date of the said therein mentioned Ordinance certain payments have been made to the Building Contractor in excess of the said sum of £5500 and the total sum actually expended amounts to £5798 6s. 9d. and certain additional payments have been made to the Architect for fees in connection with the building amounting to the sum of £17 18s. WHEREAS certain further work in regard to the fencing and grounds requires to be done upon the property comprised in the said Ordinance AND WHEREAS in consequence of the before mentioned expenditure it has become necessary to amend the said Ordinance in order to provide for such expenditure and for the expenses of this Ordinance Now therefore the Standing Committee of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 and Ordinances of the Synod passed in the years 1918 and 1921 appointing the Standing Committee for the

purposes of exercising during the recess of the Synod the powers and functions in the said Ordinance referred to and in pursuance of the powers yested in the said Synod by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales or otherwise in the name and in the place of the said Synod declares directs and rules as follows:—

- 1. Section 3 (d) of the said Ordinance shall be amended by the insertion therein of the sum of £5798 6s, 9d. in lieu of the sum of £5500 therein mentioned.
- 2. Sub-section (e) of Section 3 shall be read and construed to include not only the expenses therein mentioned but also the additional sum of £17 18s, paid to the Architect as hereinbefore mentioned and also all expenses in connection with this Ordinance.
- 3. Section 4 of the said Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following Section shall be read in place thereof.
- 4. After payment of the moneys hereinbefore referred to in Clause 3 hereof £194 3s. 3d, shall be paid to the Treasurer of the Church Buildings Loan Fund for use in aid of the objects of the said Fund and after payment thereof the sum of £1200 shall be invested by the Corporate Trustees in any stocks funds or securities of or guaranteed by the Government of the Commonwealth of Australia or of any of the States thereof or of the Dominion of New Zealand or on first mortgage of freehold properties in New South Wales with power from time to time to vary any such investments for any other or others of a like nature and pending such investments may be deposited at interest with any Government Savings Bank or with any Joint Stock Company carrying on the business of bankers in New South Wales and the ultimate balance of the said compensation moneys shall be paid to the Rector and Churchwardens of St. Bartholomew's Pyrmont to be applied by them in payment of the expense of the work done and to be done in regard to the fence and grounds of the property described in the Schedule hereto and the receipt of the said Rector and Churchwardens for all moneys paid to them under this Ordinance shall be a sufficient receipt for the moneys so paid.

5. This Ordinance may be cited as "St. Bartholomew's Pyrmont Land Resumption (Amendment) Ordinance 1926."
