## St. James' Sydney Variation of Trusts and Spire Repairs Ordinance 1972

## No. 16, 1972

An Ordinance to vary the trusts of certain funds and to authorise the use of such funds on repairs to the spire of St. James' Church Sydney.

Whereas pursuant to sub-paragraph (ii) of Clause 7 of the St. James' Sydney Phillip Street Property Ordinance 1962-1972 a fund (hereinafter called "the fund") has been accumulated for the use and benefit of the Church of England in the Diocese of Sydney for purposes other than for the use or benefit of the Parish of St. James' Sydney AND WHEREAS allocations from the fund are made from time to time by the Standing Committee AND WHEREAS by reason of circumstances which have arisen subsequent to the creation of the trusts of the fund it is inexpedient to carry out and observe the same to the extent that they are hereinafter varied NOW the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod HEREBY ORDAINS DIRECTS DECLARES AND RULES as follows:—

- By reason of circumstances which have arisen subsequent to the creation of the trusts of the fund it is inexpedient to observe and carry out the same to the extent that they are hereinafter varied.
- 2. The amount of Fifteen thousand eight hundred and two dollars (\$15,802) shall be paid from the fund to the Churchwardens of St. James' Church Sydney and applied by them for repairs to the church spire.
- 3. This Ordinance may be cited as "St. James' Sydney Variation of Trusts and Spire Repairs Ordinance 1972".
