

The St John's Parramatta Endowment Fund Ordinance 1930 Amendment Ordinance 2013

No 30, 2013

Long Title

An Ordinance to provide for a fixed term of office for trustees of the St John's Parramatta Endowment Fund.

The Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney Ordains as follows.

1. Name

This Ordinance is The St John's Parramatta Endowment Fund Ordinance 1930 Amendment Ordinance 2013.

2. Amendment of The St John's Parramatta Endowment Fund Ordinance 1930

The St John's Parramatta Endowment Fund Ordinance 1930 (the "Principal Ordinance") is amended by –

- (a) inserting after the word "Fund" in the Long Title the matter " , to provide for a fixed term of office for the Trustees of the said Fund", and
- (b) insert the following new paragraph immediately before the last paragraph in the Preamble –

"And Whereas it is expedient to provide for a fixed term of office for the Trustees of the said Fund.", and

- (c) inserting a new clause 3 as follows (with consequential renumbering of the remaining clauses) –

"Election of trustees

3. (1) Subject to section 14 of the Anglican Church of Australia Trust Property Act 1917 (the "1917 Act") and subclause (2), a person holding the office of Trustee of the said Fund holds office for a term of 5 years.

(2) A person whose office is declared vacant pursuant to Section 14 by reason of the expiry of the 5 year term referred to in subclause (1) shall continue to hold office until his or her successor is elected, and is eligible for re-election to the office of Trustee of the said Fund.", and

- (d) deleting the matter "nor for Sunday trading of any kind other than of qualified Chemists or cafes" in clause 5, and
- (e) substituting the matter "clauses 4 and 6" in clause 7(e) with the matter "clauses 5 and 7", and
- (f) substituting the number "7" in clause 7A where it appears with the number "8".

3. Transitional

(1) Subject to sub-clause (2), all persons appointed and holding office under the Principal Ordinance immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance are taken to have been appointed under the Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance.

(2) For the purposes of clause 3 of the Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, the following persons are taken to have been appointed on the following dates –
