## St. John's Sutherland Sale and Mortgage, Ordinance Amendment' Ordinance 1957.

## No. 9, 1957

An Ordinance to amend the St. John's Sutherland Sale and Mortgage Ordinance 1956.

WHEREAS by Ordinance No. 43, 1956 intituled "St. John's Sutherland Sale and Mortgage Ordinance 1956" (hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance) Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Sydney was empowered to mortgage from time to time the whole or any part of the land referred to in the second schedule thereto for a sum not exceeding Three thousand pounds (£3000) when the power was first exercised AND WHEREAS the said power has not yet been exercised AND WHEREAS the proceeds of such mortgage are to be applied when the power is first exercised in and towards the costs of and incidental to the erection of a new Rectory in the Parish of St. John the Baptist Sutherland AND WHEREAS by reason of circumstances which have arisen since the passing of the said Ordinance it has been necessary to provide for the borrowing of a further sum not exceeding One thousand five hundred pounds (£1500) for the same purpose New the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod Ordains and Directs as follows:-"Amendment Ordinance, 1957" .

- (a) This Ordinance may be cited as "St. John's Sutherland Sale and Mortgage Ordinance."
  - (b) The Principal Ordinance as hereby amended may be cited as "St. John's Sutherland Sale and Mortgage Ordinance 1956-1957."
- 2. The Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words and figures "Three thousand (£3000) "where twice occurring in Clause Four thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words and figures "Four thousand five hundred (£4,500)."
