

# St John's Wilberforce Land Sale Ordinance 1970 Amendment Ordinance 1994

No 36, 1994

An Ordinance to vary the trusts on which certain property is held.

Whereas

A. By clause 5 of the St John's Wilberforce Land Sale Ordinance 1970 (the "Principal Ordinance") a capital sum from the sale of certain land referred to in that ordinance is invested by the Property Trust and the net income is paid to the churchwardens of St John's Church Wilberforce for general parochial purposes.

B. By reason of circumstances which have arisen after the creation of the trusts on which the capital sum and income are held, it is inexpedient to carry out and observe those trusts to the extent that those trusts are hereby varied.

Now the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said such Synod Hereby Ordains, Directs, Declares and Rules as follows -

1. This ordinance may be cited as the "St John's Wilberforce Land Sale Ordinance 1970 Amendment Ordinance 1994".
2. By reason of circumstances which have arisen after the creation of the trusts on which the capital sum and income referred to in clause 5 of the Principal Ordinance are held, it is inexpedient to carry out and observe those trusts and it is expedient that the trusts be varied to the extent hereinafter provided.
3. Clause 5 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting the following words after the words "shall be" -  
"applied towards the purchase, erection and fitting out of accommodation for full-time lay workers or clergy employed by or working in the parish of Wilberforce and any remaining balance shall be".
