## Sydney Church of England Girls' Grammar School (Amendment) Ordinance 1939.

## No. 16, 1939.

An Ordinance to amend the "Sydney Church of England Girls' Grammar School Ordinance of 1895" as amended.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the "Church of England Girls' Grammar School Ordinance of 1895" as amended by providing for the election of four laymen to the "Sydney Church of England Girls' Grammar School Council" in addition to the four laymen already provided for thereby.

Now the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitution for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales ordains and rules as follows:

- 1. Four laymen may be elected by the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney to the "Sydney Church of England Girls' Grammar School Council" in addition to the four laymen provided for by the said Ordinance as amended.
- 2. Such four additional laymen when elected by the Synod shall hold office for the residue of the term of the Synod by which they were elected and be eligible for re-election.
- 3. Such four additional laymen or any of them when the Synod is not in session may be elected by the Standing Committee of the Diocese of Sydney, and any layman so appointed shall remain in office only until the next ordinary session of the Synod.
- 4. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Sydney Church of England Girls' Grammar School (Amendment) Ordinance 1939."
